

FORT BEND COUNTY MUD 81

BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION
SATURDAY, MAY 12, 2012

An election shall be held for the District (Weston Lakes) on Saturday, May 12, 2012 for the election of three Directors for the District, each of whom shall serve a four year term. The incumbents whose terms expire at that time are Directors Robert Machen, Robert Pfaffenberger and Joseph Ray LeBlanc. Director LeBlanc has chosen not to seek re-election.

Fort Bend County MUD 81 is a government subdivision and members of the Board of Directors are public officials. Therefore, the election must be conducted in accordance with the current State of Texas Election Code. There are a number of requirements that must be met to become a candidate which are:

- 1) A Candidate must be a property owner or registered voter within the District. The District includes: Weston Lakes Sections 1 through 19; the Village, Sections 1 & 2; Bradford on the Bend, Sections 1, 2 & 3; and Fairway Villas.
- 2) The name of a Candidate may not appear on the Official Ballot unless he or she files an application to be on the ballot.
- 3) The application must be filed with the Board's Secretary or the District's Attorney (Fulbright & Jaworski) no later than 5:00 P.M. on March 5, 2012.
- 4) A person may also become a Candidate via the write-in method IF such person files a "Declaration of Write-in Candidacy" no later than 5:00 P.M. on March 12, 2012.
- 5) Applications for candidacy or write-in Candidacy may be obtained from MUD 81 Board of Directors' Secretary, Vic Zdunkewicz, 5634 Westerdale, Phone 281 346 1235 or from Ms. Courtney McDonald, Paralegal. of Fulbright & Jaworski, 1301 McKinney, Suite 5100, Houston, Texas 77010, Phone 713 651 5401. Also, your Board members are always available to answer general questions related to the functions of the Board and the election. You may read the official postings which are displayed on the bulletin board on the south porch wall of the Country Club.
- 6) The last day to file for a place on the ballot is March 5, 2012.

It is important to understand that to be a qualified voter in this election, the voter must be registered to vote in Fort Bend County Precinct 3006 and be a resident within the District (defined as Weston Lakes, Sections 1 through 19, The Village, Sections 1 & 2; Bradford on the Bend, Sections 1, 2, & 3; and Fairview Villas).

EARLY VOTING by personal appearance shall be at a time and place to be announced at a later date. The time and place, when determined, will be posted on the official bulletin board (located on the south porch wall of the Country Club) and on signs to be posted at the entries of the subdivision.

The REGULAR ELECTION shall be held at a time and place to be announced at a later date. The time and place, when determined, will be posted on the official bulletin board (located on the south porch wall of the Weston Lakes Country Club) and on signs to be posted at the entries of the subdivision.
